### Infrastructure

The college has built a modern infrastructure in the form of a three storey building for B.Ed. and D.El.Ed course, a four storey building for Management/Commerce and Technology Department and a well maintained, spacious building for UG and PG Department. The buildings are designed to have all the requisite facilities for healthy and facilitative academic environment. The campus is fully secured with a boundary wall. There is a multipurpose hall, a seminar hall and a conference room to meet various needs of the students. There is also a common room for the girls.

#### Wi-Fi campus

The college has a Wi-Fi campus with 24Hrs internet broad band facility. The computer labs provide numerous computing facilities for its students and faculty.

#### Psychology Lab

Psychology Lab is equipped with various psychological tests i.e. Intelligence test, Aptitude test, Personality test, Memory test, Attitude test, Learning test, Social behavior, Scientific aptitude etc. It equips the pupil teachers with requisite skills on how to understand their pupils in the class and also to learn to administer psychological tests.



#### **Science & Mathematics Lab**

The Science & Mathematics lab is well equipped with scientific devices to enhance teaching-learning process and train the students in practical knowledge. In order to make learning real, laboratory is equipped with instruments, apparatus and chemicals etc.



#### Art and Craft Lab

To develop creative talent among the students, the art and craft lab is fully equipped with materials where students prepare their charts, models, teaching aids and show the creativity and talent in art and painting competitions.



#### **Smart Classrooms**

Smart Classrooms are used to teach faculty and students to integrate technology in their lives.

#### **Hostel Facility**

The college has double storey hostel facility for the students. Rooms are spacious and well ventilated with adequate facilities for students.

#### **Canteen & Refreshment**

The college has canteen facility and seating room. A refreshment shop caters to the taste of students and immediate need of them.

#### Security and Surveillance with CCTV

College has set up CCTV Cameras for providing safe and secure environment in the college for students and to monitor the activities in the classrooms and corridors.

#### **Sports Ground/ Gymnasium**

Well-equipped gymnasium is available within campus for students as well as faculty. Regular exercise and physical fitness boost self-esteem and concentration of the students for achieving success in life. A spacious Basket ball court has been added to sports infrastructure. There is a TT room, badminton court and a volleyball court as well in the college.

#### **Computer labs**

To keep the students abreast with technological advancement, the institution is proud to have 5 computer labs with 120 computers, various softwares with broadband internet network and multimedia facilities. The campus is fully Wi-fi connected. In the session 2020-21, 30 computer systems have been purchased with 13 processers, 4 GB RAM, 18.5" TFT with optical mouse and keyboard. The college has purchased original softwares from Microsoft viz. Microsoft operating system M.S. Office, visual studio and JAWA (ten each) costing around Rs.1,50,000.



#### **COLLEGE COMMITTEES & CELLS**

#### 1. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The College has an Internal Quality Assurance Cell established since 2014. The main aim of IQAC is planning, implementing and measuring the outcomes of academic and administrative performance of the college. After the NAAC Inspection the IQAC has been re-constituted as per the guidelines issued by NAAC.

#### 2. ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Institution conducts itself in a very tranquil environment as per the directions of Honorable Supreme Court of India, the institution protection to the new entrants from the menace of ragging. In this regards, college has constituted an Anti Ragging Cell headed by the Director along with 7 other committee members comprising of senior faculties. An Anti- Ragging squad monitors and collects feedback from the fresher and the committee analyses the situations. Anti-Ragging notifications are highlighted at various locations in the campus.

#### **3. GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL**

In order to ensure transparency and with paramount objective of preventing unfair practices and to provide a mechanism to innocent students for redressal of their grievance, the college has a students' Grievance redressal Cell. The function of the cell is to look into the complaints lodged by any of the students and to check the status. It is also empowered to look into the matters of harassment; however, no such case has been brought forth.

#### 4. WOMEN CELL

A women cell has been constituted in the college to uphold the dignity of women as per the directives of Honorable Supreme Court of India. This cell subsists to address the issues of gender discrimination and inappropriate conduct towards women. The main objective of this cell is to make students aware of Gender Equity.

#### 5. GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CELL

With the introduction of professional courses like BCA, M.A., BBA and B.Ed. a realizing the needs of fast changing world and the opportunities, the college has set up a career placement cell for the students. The cell primarily aims at obtaining the best possible placement for the final year. With the sincere efforts, 100% placement assistance has been provided to students, resulting in recruitment of BBA, BCA, MCA and MBA students in reputed companies like Wipro, Tech Mahindra, InfoTech, Siblicode, ICICI, Prudential, HDFC, and Infosys.

#### 6. SC/ST CELL

To investigate and monitor all matters relating to the safeguards provided for SC/ST students, a SC/ST cell has been constituted which looks into the specific complaints with respect to deprivation of rights and safeguard interest of SC and ST stakeholders.
